

Survey by Camera

Though it has not been possible to save the Goyt Valley from partial submergence as a Stockport waterworks, the memory of what it looks like to-day is to be given a permanent record. The council of the Stockport Photographic Society has decided to organise a photographic survey of the valley, especially those parts of it which will be affected by the new reservoirs, during the coming spring and summer. A series of landscape photographs will be taken and the points from which exposures are made will be noted. In a few years' time it is hoped to return to the same points and take a parallel series of views after the valley has been flooded. The results of the survey will be presented to local libraries as a permanent record.
