Work No. 5.—An aqueduct commencing and terminating at points in the River Goyt in the neighbourhood of the dam of the Fernilee Reservoir and to be situate in the said parish of Taxal.

Work No. 6.—An aqueduct commencing in the Fernilee Reservoir and terminating in the River Goyt and to be situate in the said parish of Fernilee.

Work No. 7.—An aqueduct commencing in the Mill Clough in Ladbitch Wood and terminating in the Fernilee Reservoir and to be situate in the said parish of Taxal.

Work No. 8.—An aqueduct commencing in an unnamed stream near Wythen Lache farmstead and terminating in the Fernilee Reservoir and to be situate in the said parish of Fernilee.

Work No. 9.—An aqueduct commencing at the termination of Work No. 2 and terminating in the intended Parkgate Reservoir Work No. 10 and to be situate in the said parish of Taxal the parish and Rural District of Disley and the parish and Urban District of Yeadsley cum Whaley all in the County of Chester and in the parishes of Fernilee and Chapel-en-le-Frith in the Rural District of Chapel-en-le-Frith and in the parish of Newtown in the Urban District of New Mills all in the County of Derby.

Work No. 10.—A service reservoir to be called the Parkgate Reservoir and to be situate in the field Nod. 564 in the said parish and Rural District of Disley as shown on the Ordnance Map Scale $\frac{1}{2500}$ Cheshire Sheet XX, 14 Edition 1909.

Work No. 11.—An aqueduct commencing in the River Goyt and terminating in the existing Reservoir known as the Mill Dam near Goytsclough Mill and to be situate in the said parish of Taxal.

Work No. 12.—An aqueduct commencing in the stream known as Deep Clough and terminating in the said Reservoir known as the Mill Dam and to be situate in the said parish of Taxal.

Work No. 13.—An aqueduct commencing in the said Reservoir known as the Mill Dam and terminating in a small service tank to be provided in the field Nod. 32 in the said parish of Disley as shown on the Ordnance Map Scale $\frac{1}{2500}$ Cheshire Sheet XXIX, 3 Edition of 1909 such aqueduct to be situate in the said parish of Taxal the said Urban District of Yeadsley cum Whaley and the said parishes of Disley Hartington Upper Quarter Fernilee and Chapel-en-le-Frith.

Work No. 14.—An aqueduct commencing in the existing Reservoir of the Rural District Council of Chapel-en-le-Frith near Bunsal Farm and terminating by a junction with the existing pipe of the said Council near the dam of the Fernilee Reservoir and to be situate in the said parishes of Hartington Upper Quarter and Fernilee.

Work No. 15.—A private carriageway connecting the private carriageway and public footpath over the dam of the Fernilee

STOCKPORT CORPORATION.

NOTICE is hereby given that application is intended to be made to Parliament in the Session of 1930 by the Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the County Borough of Stockport (hereinafter called "the Corporation" and "the Borough" respectively) for an Act of which the principal subject matters are as follows:—

1. The construction and maintenance by the Corporation of the following Waterworks:—

Work No. 1.—An impounding reservoir to be called the Errwood Reservoir to be formed by a dam across the River Goyt and to be situate in the parish of Taxal in the Rural District of Macclesfield in the County of Chester and in the parish of Hartington Upper Quarter in the Rural District of Chapel-en-le-Frith, in the County of Derby.

Work No. 2.—An aqueduct commencing and terminating at points in the River Goyt in the neighbourhood of the dam of the Errwood Reservoir and to be situate in the said parish of Taxal.

Work No. 3.—An aqueduct commencing in the Errwood Reservoir and terminating in the River Goyt and to be situate in the said parish of Hartington Upper Quarter.

Work No. 4.—An impounding reservoir to be called the Fernilee Reservoir to be formed

Reservoir with the public road from Stockport to Buxton and to be situate in the said parish of Fernilee.

Work No. 16.—A private carriageway and public footpath connecting the reputed public road or cart track from Shawstic Farm to the Bridge over the River Goyt at Fernilee Mills with the private carriageway and public footpath over the dam of the Fernilee Reservoir and to be situate in the said parish of Fernilee.

Work No. 17.—A private carriageway and public footpath connecting the private carriageway and public footpath over the dam of the Fernilee Reservoir with the reputed public road or cart track from Oldfield Farm to the Bridge over the River Goyt at Fernilee Mills and to be situate in the said parish of Taxal.

Work No. 18.—A public road or carriageway connecting the public road between Goytsclough Mill and Goyt's Bridge with the public road known as "The Street" from Goyt's Bridge and to be situate in the said parish of Taxal.

Work No. 19.—A carriageway connecting the public road known as Goyt's Lane with Work No. 18 and to be situate in the said parishes of Hartington Upper Quarter and Taxal.

Work No. 20.—A private carriageway connecting the existing private entrance drive to Errwood Hall with Work No. 18 and to be situate in the said parish of Taxal.

Work No. 21.—A private carriageway connecting the said public road known as "The Street" from Goyt's Bridge with the western end of the dam of the Errwood Reservoir and to be situate in the said parish of Taxal.

Work No. 22.—An aqueduct commencing in Parkgate Reservoir and terminating by a junction with a pipe of the Corporation in the public road between Stockport and Disley and to be situate in the said parish of Disley and the parish and Urban district of Marple in the County of Chester.

2. The collection diversion impounding using and appropriating the waters of the streams known as the River Goyt, Berry Clough, Foxhole Hollow, Deep Clough, Stake Clough, Shooters Clough and the tributary thereof draining the south eastern slopes of the Withinleach Moor, Wildmoorstone Brook, Nell Hole, Jep Clough, Deep Clough, Mill Clough and other streams not named and their respective tributaries and all or any other springs streams and waters whether above or underground within the drainage areas of the said streams or which may be intercepted by the said works or any supplementary or ancillary works in connection therewith all or some of which waters now flow into the River Goyt and thence into the River Mersey and thence into the Estuary of the River Mersey and to make special provision as to the taking of all or any of the said streams springs and waters prior to the completion and first filling of the intended Reservoirs or either of them.

3. The provision of compensation water to the rivers and streams affected; the discharge of water into any available stream or water-course; provisions for securing the purity of

water; the construction of subsidiary and additional works.

4. The alteration and increase of the rates and charges chargeable by or payable to the Corporation for water supplies meters and fittings; the future revision of such rates and charges and the amendment or repeal of enactments relating to such rates and charges.

5. Further provisions with regard to the supply of water by the Corporation, communication pipes cisterns valves and other apparatus.

6. The construction and maintenance by the Corporation of a new road wholly in the Borough and to be supported on a bridge over and above and following the course of the River Mersey commencing on the north easterly side of Mersey Bridge and terminating on the south westerly side of Lancashire Bridge.

7. The acquisition by the Corporation of lands and easements in the parishes and urban and rural districts aforesaid for the purposes of or connected with the proposed waterworks and of lands and easements in the borough for the purposes of the proposed new road and for other purposes to be specified in the Bill including for the purposes of a filter house settling tanks and other works for the filtration of water and other works in connection with the water undertaking a piece of land situate in the Urban District of Denton in the County of Lancaster containing 1 acre 2 roods and 26 perches or thereabouts and having a frontage to Windmill Lane.

8. The reservation of frontage to the said new road, the extinguishment of rights of way, the stopping up of roads footpaths &c. and the maintenance and repair of the roads and carriage ways proposed to be constructed under the Bill.

9. The exemption of the Corporation from the operation of Section 92 of the Lands Clauses Consolidation Act 1845 in certain cases and the enactment of certain amendments of the Lands Clauses Acts in their application to the Corporation and of special provisions for assessing compensation for lands acquired under the intended Act; empowering the Corporation to erect buildings on and to develop lands belonging to them or to let the same on building leases and conferring other provisions as to the retention and disposal of lands.

10. The enactment of further provisions as to the acquisition by the Corporation of lands by agreement for the benefit of the Borough and for the exercise of their powers and duties.

11. The borrowing of money by the Corporation for and in connection with the purchase of lands and the execution of the Works hereinbefore referred to and for the purposes of the Bill and other financial matters including the establishment of a Consolidated loans fund and reserve fund the use of sinking and other funds instead of borrowing, the method of meeting deficiencies in the undertakings of the Corporation, the application of revenue, the method of keeping accounts &c. and other miscellaneous provisions.

12. The incorporation repeal and amendment of Acts and Orders both general and local and the enactment of all incidental provisions.

Plans and sections of the works hereinbefore described including plans of the lands

proposed to be acquired under the Bill together with a book of reference to the plans will on or before the 30th day of November instant be deposited for public inspection with the Clerk of the Peace for the County Palatine of Lancaster at his office at Preston with the Clerk of the Peace for the County of Chester at his office at Chester and with the Clerk of the Peace for the County of Derby at his office at Derby and on or before the said 30th day of November a copy of so much of the said plans sections and book of reference as relates to the Borough will be deposited with the Town Clerk at his office at the Town Hall in the Borough and a copy of so much of the said plans sections and book of reference as relates to each of the several areas hereinafter mentioned will on or before the said 30th day of November be deposited as follows:—

As relates to the Rural District of Macclesfield with the Clerk to the District Council at the Rural District Council Offices, Macclesfield.

As relates to the Rural District of Chapel en le Frith with the Clerk to the District Council at the Council Offices Chapel en le Frith.

As relates to the Rural District of Disley with the Clerk to the District Council at the Council Offices Disley.

As relates to the Urban District of Yeardsley cum Whaley with the Clerk to the District Council at his office in High Street, Stockport.

As relates to the Urban District of New Mills with the Clerk to the District Council at the Town Hall New Mills.

As relates to the Urban District of Marple with the Clerk to the District Council at the Council Offices Marple.

As relates to the Urban District of Denton with the Clerk to the District Council at the Town Hall Denton.

As relates to the parishes of Taxal, Hartington Upper Quarter, Fernilee, Disley and Chapel en le Frith with the Clerks to the parish Councils thereof respectively at their offices (if any) and if in any case there be no clerk then with the Chairman of the Parish Council at his residence.
